#### **NCGC Staff Update**

- **Outcomes from the NCGC Latino Mini-Grant Program are attached.**
  - If Latino mini-grants are awarded during OE4, partners suggested that NCGC collect information on Medicaid enrollment. Also, partners felt that \$5,000 per mini-grant was a sufficient amount to award organizations to enhance their ACA outreach and enrollment activities.
  - ACA Project Specialist, Deborah Owens, talked about her experiences working with Jan Plummer of Mountain Projects, Inc. to enroll five families from a federally recognized tribe that had recently moved to Siler City. The enrollment event was held the day before the NCGC Coalition Meeting, on June 16<sup>th</sup>.
