- More detailed than 1115 Medicaid Waiver/ Some things will need legislative approval as well as CMS approval/ Proposal will also be modified based on public input
- Written comments accepted through September 8
- Competitive bid process for enrollment brokers/ Enrollment brokers will help people select prepaid plans and providers
- It hasn't been determined whether or not DSS will hire more workers to meet enrollment demands/ NC DHHS sees a role for ACA enrollment assisters because they are familiar with public and private sides of Medicaid/ Individuals will also move in and out of Medicaid
- The Ombudsman program will be external from NC DHHS/ Will act as an external advocate to provide real-time issue resolutions
