Too many members still only using insurance in emergency

- + Preventive care covered 100%
- + Selecting a PCP increases likelihood of using PCP
- + As limited network plans (Blue Value and Blue Local) become more common, need to understand where to go
- + Lower income members tend to be the least engaged

OUTREACH



Lots of programs, limited results

- + Mail campaigns
- + Email campaigns
- + Phone calls
- + Still not seeing good results in these campaigns

ONBOARDING EVENTS



In person events

- + Join with systems (i.e. Novant, UNC) to hold events
- + Systems will provide the venue and staff to help select PCP, sign up for preventive care visits, etc
- + Initial events will be split between a rural system (UNC Wayne) and urban (Novant)
- + BCBSNC will provide staff to assist with technical side (Blue Connect account creation, find a doctor and app set up if available)
