# **Key Elements**

- ► A North Carolina Strategy should include:
- ► Access: Eliminate disparities and gaps in healthcare coverage so all North Carolinians can access health care.
- Affordability: Healthcare coverage and services should be affordable for all North Carolinians.
- Accountability: All North Carolinians should receive affordable, high quality health care. Preventive benefits should be an essential component of meaningful health care coverage.
- Jobs: Promote growing and diversifying North Carolina's health care workforce.



#### **Action Plan**

- Care4Carolina will grow the coalition to build the clout needed to lead a conversation about access to affordable healthcare for all.
- Care4Carolina is committed to spotlighting challenges facing rural communities particularly with access and quality.
- Care4Carolina will engage people and communities to increase awareness of the disparities that people face in receiving basic healthcare and the consequences to them, their families and North Carolina.



## Insurance Gaps

- In North Carolina currently a coverage gap exists for more than 300,000 low-income individuals that have no affordable health insurance options available to them.
- Medicaid currently covers fewer than half of people in poverty.
- In NC there are nearly 12,000 low-income veterans without access to comprehensive health insurance coverage.
- Fishermen, farmers, volunteer firefighters, small business owners are not able to get healthcare coverage.
