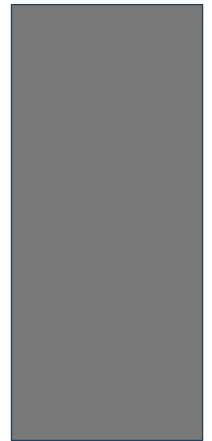

- We were able to assist a Nicaraguan Family. Her Husband was diagnosed with Prostate Cancer in 2014.
- They were enrolled in 2015 in a bronze plan paying \$150/mo. And it did not include their PCP nor their treatment.

- They got enrolled in a Silver plan including their doctors for less than \$50/mo., with a \$500 deductible and \$800 out of pocket.
