Open Enrollment Results

- **NC Open Enrollment 1:**
 - 357,584 North Carolinians enroll
 - 91% with financial assistance
 - 5th highest in U.S.
- **NC Open Enrollment 2:**
 - 560,357 North Carolinians enroll
 - 51% new consumers – 285,782
 - 49% re-enrollees – 274,575
 - 92% with financial assistance
 - 4th highest in U.S.



Next Open Enrollment Period

- **November 1, 2015** – Open Enrollment Begins
- **December 15, 2015** – Last Day to Enroll for Coverage on January 1
- **January 31, 2016** – Open Enrollment Ends
- **Special Enrollment Period**

NC Enrollment Structure

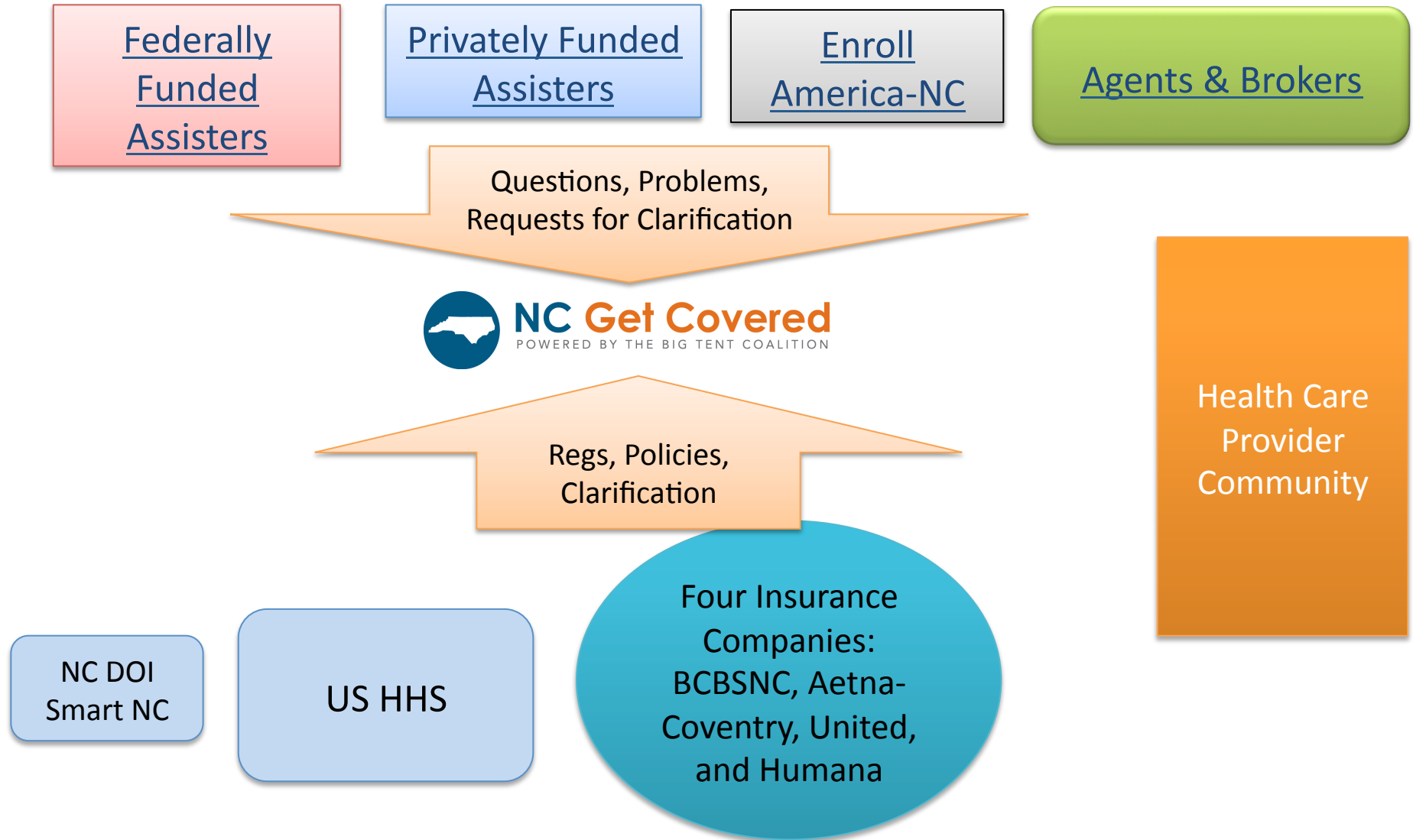
